<p>(1)(A) Contacting the Licensing supervisor or designee who made the waiver or variance decision to discuss alternative options, who may further amend the waiver or variance as a result of this contact. If you and the Licensing supervisor or designee cannot reach an agreement, you may request an administrative review (see Subchapter M, Division 1 of this chapter (relating to Administrative Reviews)); or</p> <p>(1)(B) Requesting an administrative review (see Subchapter M, Division 1 of this chapter) without contacting the Licensing supervisor or designee who made the waiver or variance decision to discuss alternative options.</p>	<p>(2)(A) Comply with the conditions until the expiration date;</p> <p>(2)(B) Comply with the minimum standard that was the subject of the waiver or variance after the expiration date if the decision sought under (1)(A) or (1)(B) is not complete by the expiration date.</p>
