Infants	Five, with a maximum of two infants and two more children less than six years old, unless the placement is necessary to maintain a sibling group of children.
Three or more children receiving treatment services	Four
One child or more receiving treatment services for primary medical needs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Four, with a maximum of one child with primary medical needs requiring total care, unless the placement is necessary to maintain a sibling group of children; or</li> <li>• Two, if all placements are children with primary medical needs requiring total care, unless the placement is necessary to maintain a sibling group of children.</li> <li>• Foster family homes verified to provide treatment services to children with primary medical needs before January 1, 2015, may continue to care for up to four children with no limitation.</li> </ul>
